

# Dawood Engineering Diversity Scholarship

## Guidelines

- Scholarship value \$ 2,000.00 per person.
- This scholarship may be awarded up to two (2) times to the same person (1 time annually), while the person is registered in an educational training program.
- Selection is based on candidate's potential to contribute to the cultural, ethnic and socioeconomic diversity of the community campus of their choice.
- Scholarship renewal is based on maintaining a full-time undergraduate course load and making satisfactory progress towards a degree in one of the disciplines offered at Dawood.
- Up to two (2) recipients per year.

## Application Process

Candidate must complete:

- Part I - Applicant Information
- Part II – Nomination Information
- Part III – Nominator Recommendation
- Part IV – Sealed Letter from Nominator
- Part V – Essay/ Video/ Media Presentation

Nominations may be made by an individual (Teacher, Counselor, Employer, Minister, etc.) nominating a candidate for the scholarship.

A sealed letter of recommendation.

The candidate shall submit written essay, video, or media presentation (no longer than 10 min in length) stating why her/his diverse background will contribute to his/her future success.

With application the candidate must submit a resume of honors, awards, leadership, positions and community service or other activities during high school.

Existing employees are not eligible, however family members enrolled in a program may apply.

Must be received by May 31, 2022.
